Technical duties:

- Work closely with veterinarian in regards to evolving medical and technical needs
- Assist with medical procedures as required
- Assist with necropsy as required
- Assist with sedation and anesthesia procedures must be experienced in veterinary technical skills such as placing IV catheters, monitoring anesthesia, blood draws, administering basic medical treatments under direction of the veterinarian

Cub keeper duties:

- Overall care and training of cheetah cubs
- Medical training of cheetah cubs to enable voluntary participation in medical procedures such blood draws, x-rays and movement of transfer via crates to reduce stress and risks of unnecessary sedations.
- In conjunction with the veterinarian, managing evolving cub diets and nutrition as per protocol.
- Ability to work closely with locally trained cheetah keeper and staff
- Data entry of feed logs, weights etc into electronic medical database (Zims species 360)

Clinic duties:

- Care of sick cheetahs residing at the clinic
- Managing the smooth operations of the day to day business of the clinic
- Timely ordering of stores both locally and from overseas.
- Managing inventory
- Managing the cleanliness of the clinic
- Minuting meetings
- Working alongside vet to ensure all handwritten medical records (ie medication prescriptions) are kept up to date in electronic medical database (ZIMS Species 360)
